## Miners Foundry • Celebrating 150 Years of Gold Country History

Miners Foundry Cultural Center, a state historic landmark, was once a noisy, gritty manufacturing site that produced equipment for the burgeoning gold mining industry of the mid-1800's. Now, through several changes of ownership and function, Miners Foundry is a lively cultural center serving Nevada County as a site for concerts, conferences, weddings, festivals, and many other public and private events. The Foundry is a non-profit trust; Artisans Festival is its biggest fundraiser of the year.

**Features** of this show include optional central Mastercard/Visa service, electricity to each booth, pleasant entertainment, food and drink, and a charming and historic atmosphere. The building is decorated for the holiday season. This is a small but tasty show with about 36 artists. The artist's presence is required all three days -- no reps!

**Eligible media:** painting, photography, prints, sculpture; wood, fiber, stone, clay, metals, leather, etc. **Not eligible:** food items, t-shirts, "country" crafts, taped music, imported goods, buy-and-sell, items made from kits or commercial molds.

**Jurying** is all-at-once by photos or CD only. The entire group of applicants will be juried; previous exhibitors do not have priority. CD specs: 300 dpi images, tiff or jpeg; photographs must be true photos -- not computer prints. Please -- no images with watermarks or time/date stamps.

**Jewelers:** We receive more applications in jewelry than any other category, by far. We jury for variety as well as quality; accepted jewelers represent about 20% of the festival's participants.

**Booth Sizes:** 8Wx 8D feet OR 11W x 6D. Number of 11 x 6 spaces is limited to 8. Indicate your choice on the attached application.

**Booth Fee:** \$235. We do not offer double booths.
